**Telemedicine** Currently, we conduct consultations by telephone with patients three days per week. Our future plans include allowing video chat access to our patient population. Use of this method will involve greater technology needs so we have purchased a subscription for true telemedicine. Thanks to a recent grant award from North Texas Community Foundation, this need has been met.

Upgrades are being implemented to the record keeping and clinical charting at the clinic with the purchase of dental and pharmacy software. We are grateful for the funds that have allowed these implementations.

**Drive Up Patient Care** We are employing drive-up ministry to monitor our most vulnerable diabetic patients with lab testing crucial to the management of their disease.



Although our traditional Back to School Health Check could not be hosted this year, we hosted a Drive Up Shots event with the UNT Pediatric Mobile Clinic for vital children's vaccinations. 57 children received vaccinations. Thanks to donations from several individuals and Bible study groups from Travis Avenue Baptist Church, we were able to give backpacks filled with gospel stories to the children that day. A special treat in the backpacks was a beautiful homemade mask created by several friends of the clinic who are seamstresses.
