## Focused on our mission statement

2021 has been a full year of ministry for Mercy Clinic.

Here are some of the highlights of this year.

- Provided COVID 19 testing for our region in collaboration with CVS Health
- Hosted COVID 19 vaccine clinics in partnership with Texas Health Resources, CVS Health, and Randall's Tom Thumb Pharmacy.
- Hosted Pop-Up health clinics in the 76104 and 76110 Zip codes with health screenings and health information
- Hosted several mobile mammograms days and other cancer screening exams with UT Southwestern Moncrief Cancer Institute and Texas Health Resources .
- Facilitated vision screening monthly with Prevent Blindness Texas
- Collaborated with Better Vision, Better Hope for diabetic eye exams
- Added new volunteers in all positions
- Updated staff positions, including a part time administrative assistant, two dental assistants, and a part time interpreter as well as the departures of our Director of Development Doug Price and Medical Director, Jack Keen M.D. Best wishes to Doug in his new position. Dr. Jack Keen has retired as our founding Medical Director. We are indebted to his leadership and vision.
- Initiated a partnership with the UNT TCU School of Medicine for evening clinic sessions
- Offered telehealth communication with our patients three days per week
- Offered in person patient care sessions three times per week
